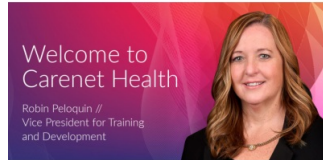


Carenet Health Hires Robin Peloquin as Its New Vice President for Training and Development
