In the XGEO exhibit, GC80, which targets large- and medium-sized hospitals, will introduce Samsung Electronics' high-quality DR performance through panel detectors. Attendees also have a chance to look into soft handling technology that allows users to move the device with low physical pressure even without a side-handle.
